The Gifted & Talented Education minor prepares individuals for a State of Idaho endorsement with either an elementary or secondary certification. This endorsement enables a teacher to work with gifted and talented students in grades kindergarten through 12 (K-12). It also allows teachers to work as a G/T Facilitator or a G/T Director/Coordinator. Students interested in this endorsement must integrate the gifted and talented education courses into their elementary or secondary teacher education program. Teacher candidates must also complete certification in either elementary education or secondary education. Courses should be taken in order listed.

Students desiring additional information should contact a member of the faculty within the Education Division.

The Idaho Teacher Certification Manual (rev. 2008) currently lists no state-mandated Praxis II exam for content assessment. Endorsement requirements are subject to change.
