It also meets the twelve counselor functions as outlined by the Idaho Board of Alcohol/Drug Certification, Inc. (IBADACC), as well as related issues. The counselor core functions are 1) treatment planning, 2) counseling, 3) crisis intervention, 4) case management, 5) assessment, 6) screening, 7) client education, 8) referral, 9) reports/record keeping, 10) intake, 11) orientation, and 12) consulting with other professionals.

The 32-35 credits of required course work for the **addictions studies** minor will meet the educational credentialing requirements outlined by the IBADACC, Idaho Students of Addictions Studies (ISAS), and Certified Alcohol/Drug Counselor (CADC). Additional course work is required for the state of Washington.
