NOTES ON THE PORTFOLIO AND ARTIFACTS

The Professional Portfolio is an electronic portfolio. Candidates will import their evidence to their assigned file on the Division of Education server at [http://teachercandidate.lsc.edu/~\(type in first initial and last name\)](http://teachercandidate.lsc.edu/~(type in first initial and last name)) or submit the portfolio on CD/DVDs. The portfolio must have a title page with the candidate's photo and links to the candidate's resume and Philosophy/Belief Statement (ED 214/ED 310). Each standard, e.g. Dedicated Professional, must contain the definition of the standard and its attributes as provided by the Division plus the candidate's interpretation of the standard. Each artifact must contain a link to the candidate's explanation about how the artifact demonstrates the candidate has met the standard (reference the attributes of the standard). Candidates may add additional evidence in an appendix. Candidates may modify the appearance and even organization of the Portfolio Template, e.g. change colors, backgrounds, place the candidate's interpretation of the standard on the same page as the standard and its attributes. Each artifact may be used only once in the portfolio. A variety of different artifacts may be related to the same event, e.g. the instructional unit. A single artifact should not be used more than once.
