LCSC provides innovative pathways in Idaho, the Northwest, and around the world for individuals who want to earn a teaching certificate and endorsement but can't attend regularly scheduled on-campus classes. *PACE* utilizes hybrid/Internet and/or stand-alone asynchronous Internet courses, both supplemented by IVC Internet personal computer cameras. These cameras allow observation of teaching at distant sites and participation in live seminars. Acceleration is possible based upon documented life experience and demonstrated teaching skills. Endorsements in selected fields may be earned in combination with Elementary and Secondary teaching certification or, for those who already have certification, as additional teaching endorsements.

## ELEMENTARY TEACHING

**Cohorts Available At Coeur d'Alene  
and Lewiston, Idaho**

The *PACE* Elementary Pathway is targeted to para-educators and others who want to earn Elementary Teaching Certification. It allows individuals to earn a Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education as well as teaching certification. The program includes two eight-week summer sessions, an on-line academic year between the summer sessions, and Internship (Student Teaching) after the second summer session. Minimum admission requirements include an associate degree or its equivalent including completion of specific undergraduate general education core classes. The program is adaptable for individuals who already have a BA/BS degree. Summer sessions include a wealth of supervised field experiences working in schools located in the Lewiston-Clarkston and Post Falls areas. Acceleration is possible through documented life experiences and demonstrated teaching skills. Student teaching can be completed in a school near the candidate's home or with administrative approval, in the school where the candidate is employed. IVC Internet cameras permit candidates to participate in live seminars, and college faculty can observe classroom teaching. Each summer a new Elementary Cohort is formed to begin the program. Apply by March 1<sup>st</sup> for admission.

## SECONDARY TEACHING

**Asynchronous Online Instruction To  
Your Home**

The *PACE* Secondary Pathway offers opportunities for individuals with BA/BS degrees to earn Secondary Teaching Certification for grades 6-12. Individuals can begin preparing for a career in secondary teaching while employed in another occupation or serving in the military. The required education courses are delivered to the individual's home using asynchronous Blackboard Internet supplemented by IVC cameras. Candidates may begin the program fall, spring, or summer semesters. Completion of the three-day on-campus New Candidate Orientation/Workshop in mid-June is required before full admission to the final phase of the program - Internship (Student Teaching). Individuals have up to four years to complete the program, full or part time. The majority of candidates complete the program in three-four semesters. Acceleration is possible for individuals with documented life experiences and demonstrated teaching skills. *PACE* also supports the Idaho Alternative option for non-certified teachers in the schools. Candidates complete internships in schools near their homes including approved schools overseas.
